- You could get wound up about it, or chill and enjoy the core business of teaching your wee petals ways to add scrumptious details to their writing and use full stops instead of commas.


#### All the pages in this document have:

  don't always seem logical but...sigh...


Note, some images have a thick red border. They're your key go-to sites!

Outlines outcomes for each standard, but this information is reflected in the standards themselves and the matrix, so...meh (IMHO!)







EL Assessment Support Material Levels 1-4






