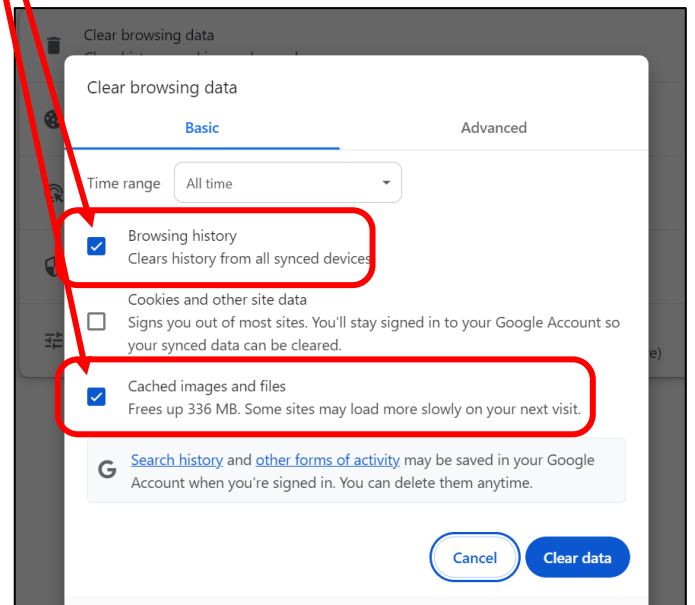
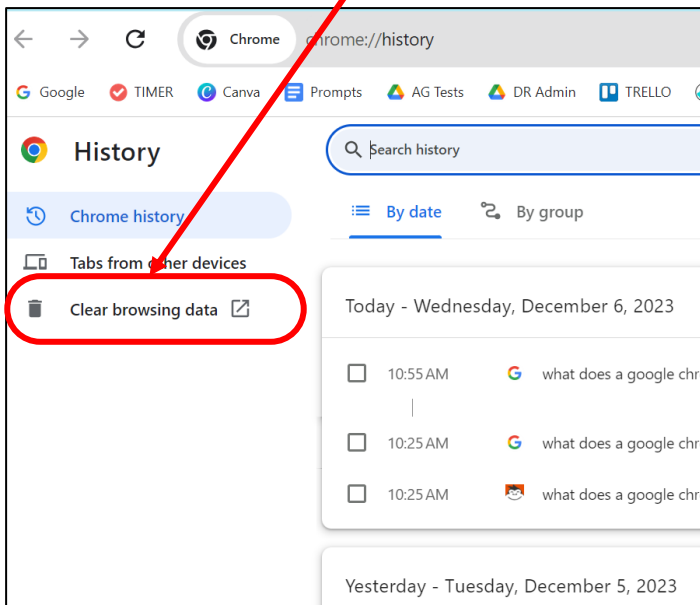
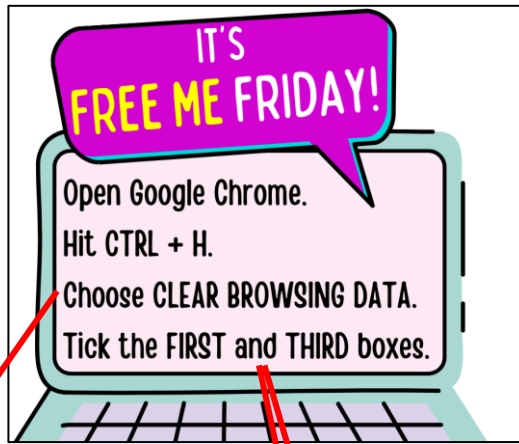
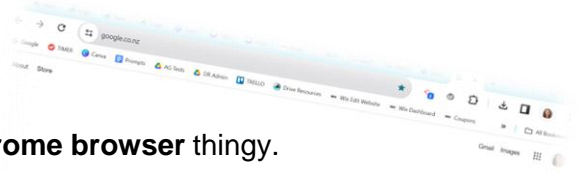
Whatever! Make these 3 tweaks a weekly thing to prevent loooaaads of laptop problems

1. Google Chrome: Declutter

Clear out with these simple steps, beginning from your **Google Chrome browser thingy**.



You'd be surprised at the number of seemingly unrelated issues this fixes! It's like the magic elixir, baby!

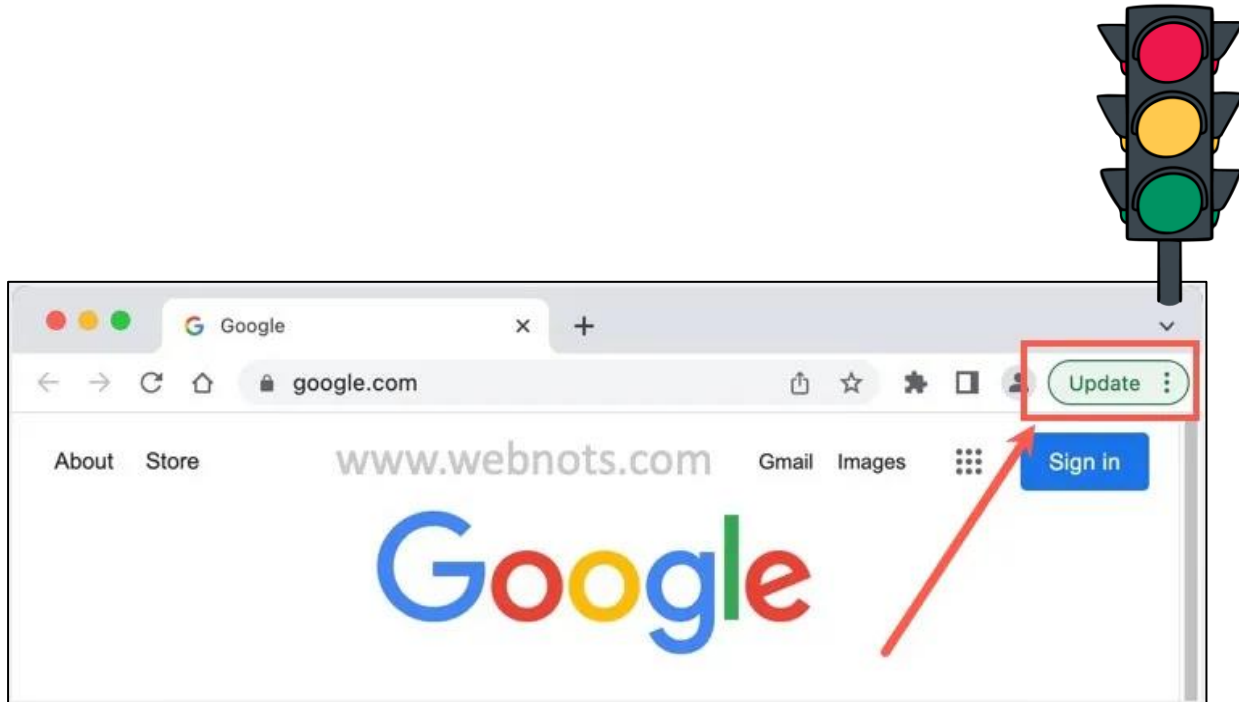


2. Google again: Update

As soon as you see the little **Update** sign at the top right of your Google Chrome browser, **click on it!** **Get it updating!**

In the image below the **Update** notification is in **green**. It works on a traffic light system. If you don't do it, it'll go **orange**, then **red**.

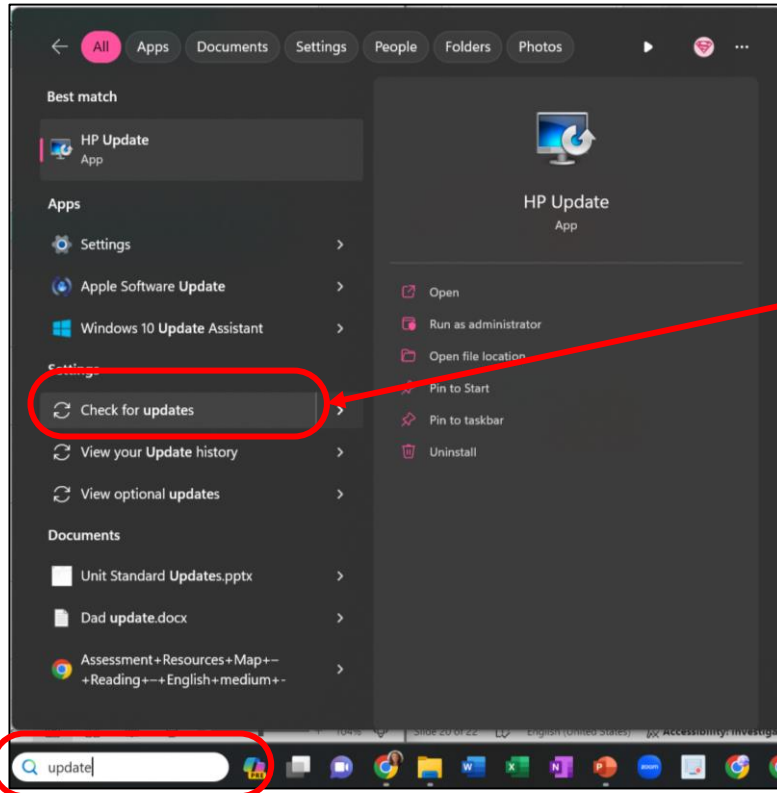
If yours is red, you're naughty and your laptop is livid! LOL.



3. Windows Update

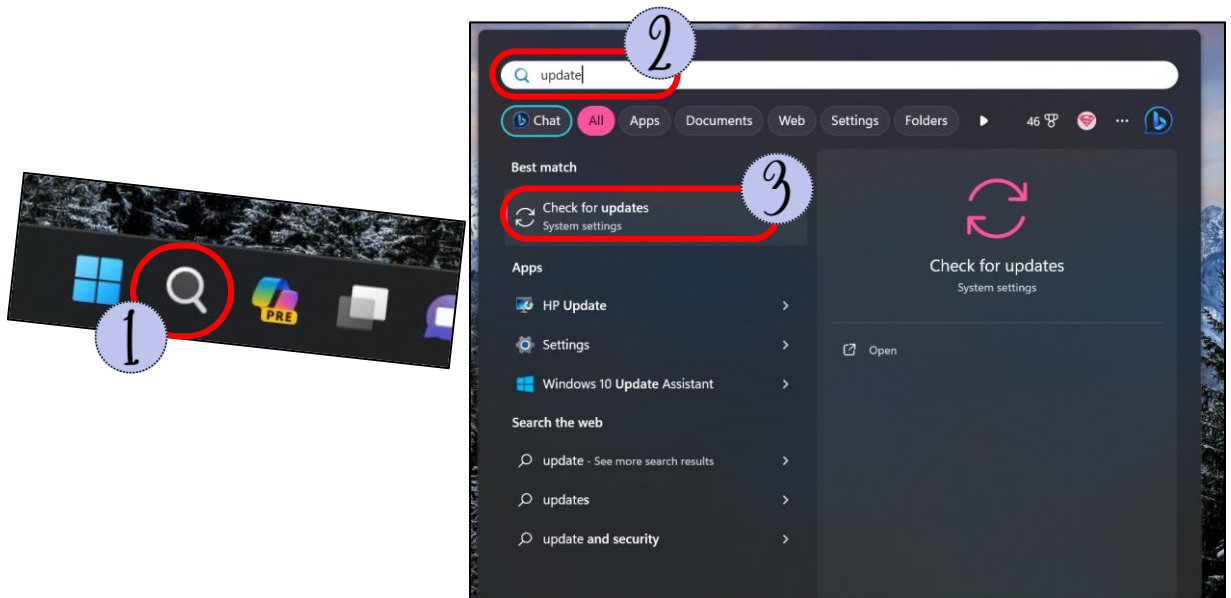
Don't freak out! This might sound techy, and it kind of is, but you just need to tick a few boxes, push a few buttons and your amazing little laptop **will do the work for you!**

 - c. Type in **update**.

That's okay, you're just searching for that **Check for updates** thingy.

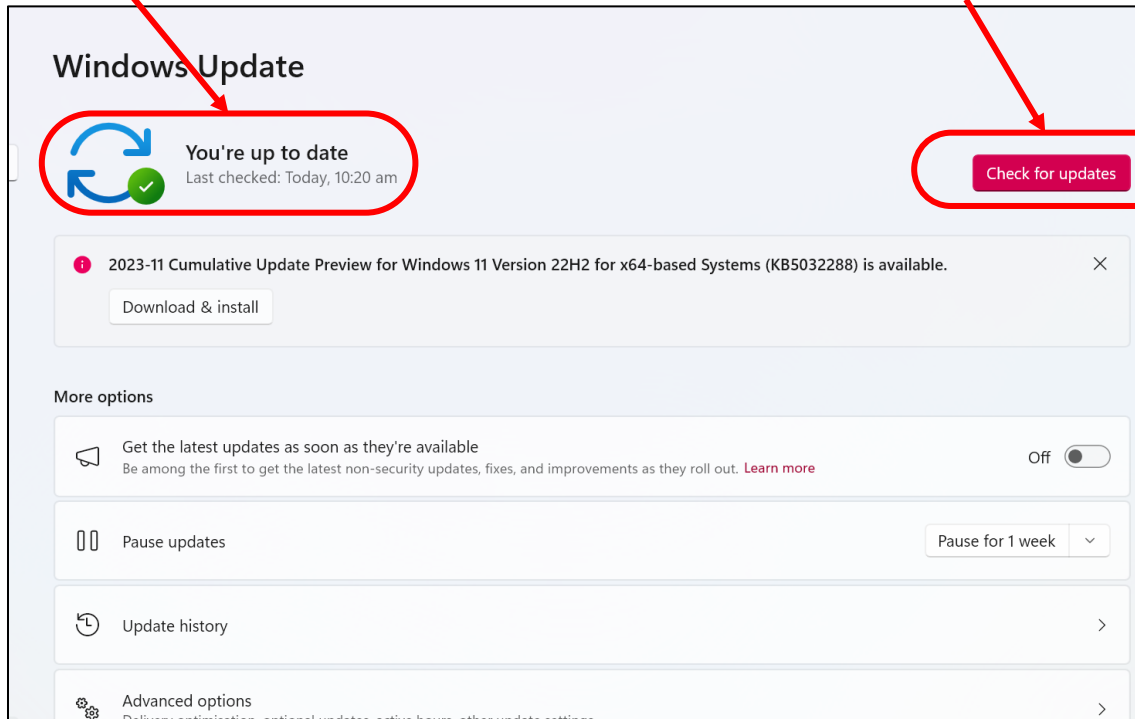


Windows update continued...

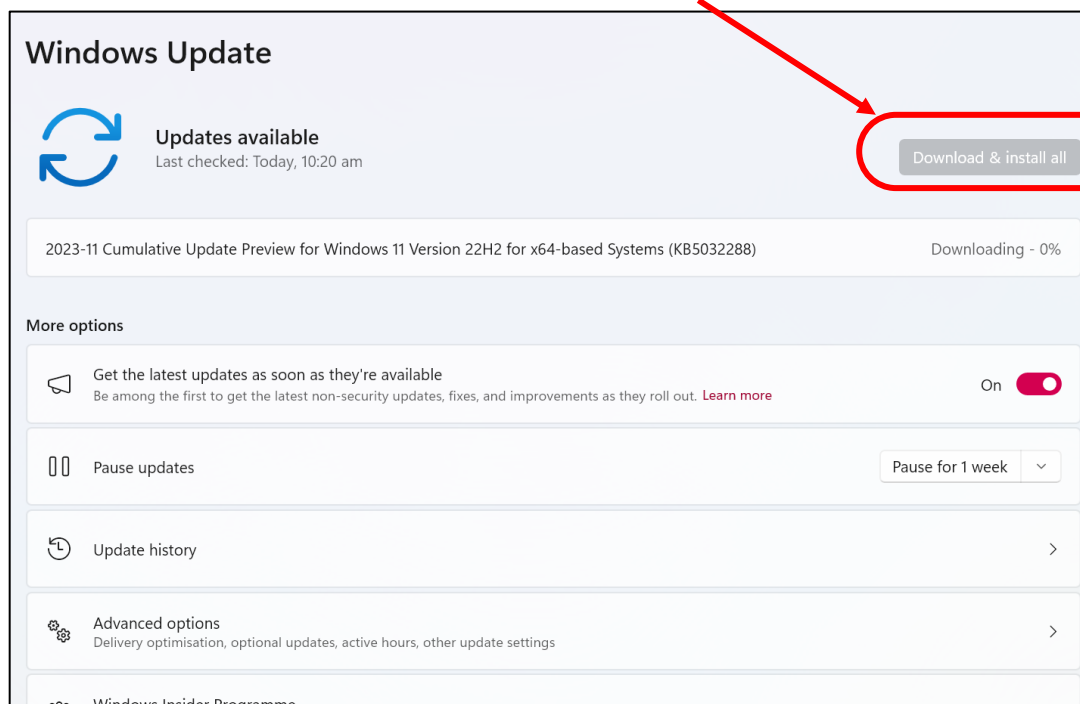
Click on **Check for updates**.
